

Reminders

Tennis Balls

Tennis balls are one of our largest expenses. Unlike most clubs we provide all the balls for our members to

play with, whether for matches or just general play. Could we remind you all to look after them!

Please only take one can of balls on court when you play, and please do collect them up if they go out of court when you finish and return them in the can to the clubhouse.

If they are wet, leave them out to dry so they will be ready for the next players, and please do not take them away from the club. They are there for everyone.

A question was raised for discussion at the AGM whether we should stop providing balls and reduce the membership fee. The annual cost of us providing the balls works out at around £10 per member, so it was agreed unanimously that we would continue with the existing arrangement.

Clubhouse

Please keep the clubhouse door closed, we've had problems in the past meaning there is damage to the hinges, so it could be a real problem if the wind catches it and it swings open.

Internet

Internet access in the clubhouse is a service for the RSCC and should not be used by BTC members. We have suggested they change the password, but please do not access it. It is something we don't pay for as a club.

Club Open Tournament

The invitations will be coming out shortly for the Club Open Tournament, you can enter singles, doubles, mixed or veterans. Finals weekend will be 14th and 15th September. Please note if you cannot make that date, do not enter the tournament.
